Instructions	<p><b>Stool in formalin screwtop container.</b> Formalin can be added to fresh (undiluted), refrigerated specimens up to 72 hours old; formalin can be added to room temperature fresh (undiluted) specimens up to 8 hours old. Testing should be performed within 1 month.</p>			
<p><b>Rejection Criteria:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Specimens received in grossly leaking containers.</li><li>Specimens in Eco-Fix transport media.</li><li>Specimens received in commercially prepared transport vials that are overfilled or underfilled with the patient specimen will be rejected for testing.</li><li>Colonoscopy and colon wash specimens cannot be tested.</li><li>Raw stool specimens received in the laboratory more than 2 hours after collection cannot be tested.</li></ul>
