Clinical Use	Useful for screening for prostate cancer. Useful for monitoring patients with a history of prostate cancer.
Notes	Testing performed via Abbott Architect Immunoassay method. Results obtained with different assay methods should not be used interchangeably in serial testing. It is recommended that only one assay method be used consistently to monitor each patient's course of therapy.
